Archuleta County

<u>Archuleta County Medical Shuttles</u> (970) 264-2167 or (970) 264-2250

*Paratransit services are available for persons unable to reach a bus stop or with medical issues that keep them from using the Fixed Route System. To make a reservation, you must call (970) 264-2250 at least one day in advance by 3:00 pm. Please leave your name, address, phone number, and the date and time the service is needed.

Archuleta County Department of Human Services (ACDHS)

The Archuleta County Department of Human Services coordinates NEMT for Medicaid Health First Colorado recipients who have no other means of transportation. DHS requests mileage reimbursement on the recipients' behalf for transportation to and from covered non-emergency medical appointments with a Health First Colorado enrolled provider. Mileage reimbursement for medical appointments.

Archuleta County Transportation (970) 264-2250

The Senior Center offers on-demand non-emergency medical transportation to Durango, which is about 60 miles west of Pagosa.

Para Transit/Dial-A-Ride (970) 264-2250

A non-emergency medical transportation service for people who have medical issues or are unable to reach a bus stop. To make a reservation, call at least 24 hours in advance. The cost per ride is \$4 one-way in town for verified seniors, and \$8 one-way in town for non-seniors.

<u>Pagosa Cab</u> (970) 398-0123

The fair as of June 8, 2024, begins at \$5.00 and the cost per mile is \$3.50. The hours are early morning by appointment or 8:00 AM to 12:00 AM.

Dolores County

Dolores County Senior Services (970) 677-2787

Senior and Public Transportation provides a Demand Response Transit service for area residents. Service hours are 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday - Friday and for prescheduled special events. 24-hour notice is requested to schedule rides. Scheduling of rides is determined on a first-call basis.

Transportation is provided from Dove Creek to the surrounding communities of Cahone, Egnar, Pleasant View, Cortez, Durango, Monticello, and Moab in Utah, and Farmington, New Mexico. In scheduling, medical access trips take precedence. A set fare schedule for public clients and a suggested donation schedule for senior clients is provided. Medicaid transportation is also provided through cooperation with Social Services in identifying clients that qualify.

For a medical appointment in Dove Creek, Durango, or Farmington, we MUST HAVE A 2-WEEK NOTICE when you get your appointment call to schedule a ride. To schedule a ride, call the number listed above a day before you need a ride (if not medical).
