Insurance Coverage

Medicare (Federal Program)

- **Original Medicare (Parts A & B):** Generally, Medicare does **not** cover wigs, as they are considered cosmetic items.
- **Medicare Advantage (Part C):** Some plans may offer additional benefits, including coverage for wigs. It's essential to check with individual plan providers for specific details.

Medicaid (State Programs)

Medicaid coverage for wigs varies by state. Here's information specific to Colorado, Arizona, and New Mexico:

- **Colorado:**
 - **Health First Colorado (Colorado's Medicaid Program):** The official benefits list does not explicitly mention coverage for wigs or cranial prostheses. However, Medicaid programs often consider such items under durable medical equipment or prosthetics if deemed medically necessary. Patients should contact Health First Colorado directly to inquire about potential coverage and necessary documentation.
- **Arizona:**
 - **Arizona Health Care Cost Containment System (AHCCCS):** Specific information regarding wig coverage is not readily available in public resources. Patients are encouraged to reach out to AHCCCS to determine if wigs are covered under durable medical equipment or prosthetic services when prescribed by a physician.
- **New Mexico:**
 - **New Mexico Medicaid:** There is limited publicly available information regarding wig coverage. As with other states, coverage may be possible if a wig is considered medically necessary and prescribed by a healthcare provider. Beneficiaries should contact the New Mexico Medicaid office for detailed information.

Private Insurance

- **Coverage Variability:** Many private insurance plans offer coverage for wigs, especially when hair loss is due to medical treatments like chemotherapy. Policies differ, so it is crucial for patients to:
 - **Review Their Policy:** Understand the terms and conditions related to durable medical equipment or prosthetics.
 - **Obtain a Prescription:** Have their physician prescribe a "cranial prosthesis" to meet insurance requirements.
 - **Contact Their Insurance Provider:** Discuss the coverage specifics, reimbursement procedures, and any preferred suppliers.
